Spring - March-May:

Midges / Choronomids #24 -22 Darker colors for early season. Dark Dun / Grey / Black adults, emerger and pupa.

BWO Baetis #16-22 Dark grey wing with dark olive body. Olive "No Hackles", traditionals, soft hackles, emergers and Parachute Adams.

Grannom Caddis #14-16, Dark brown/black bodies females with green egg sack. Elk hairs, Goddard's, fluttering caddis, etc. Emerging and pupa patters also.

Ants #16-10 Black / brown. Foam, spun, epoxy or balsa bodies. Tape or cello wings for the bigger flying ants.

Nymphs #14-22 Dark brown bead heads, PT's, Flashbacks, Copper Johns, Midge Pupas, Prince, etc.

Streamers #8-4 Dark and Bright colors. Cone head buggers, ESL's, Clousers, Articulated Leech, Double Bunnies, etc.

Royal Wullf's #16-12 Traditional and Assorted Colors

Summer - June-Mid Sept:

Midges / Choronomids #24 Neon Green with white wing adult. Also Cream and Black. Grey / Black emerger and pupa.

PMD's #14-18 Wings get darker grey later season, body is pale yellow/grey. Parachute, Thorax, Compara or Emerging PMD's with trailing shuck, soft hackles and Rusty Spinners.

BWO Baetis #16-22 Dark grey wing with dark olive body. Olive "No Hackles", traditionals, soft hackles, emergers and Parachute Adams.

Caddis #14-20 Brown and Black. Elk hairs, Goddard's, etc. Emerging and pupa patterns also.

Hoppers #10-6 Sage / Brown with pale yellow body. Dave's, parachute, foam bodied, Swishers PMX or similar.

Ants #16-10 Black/brown. Foam, spun, epoxy, or balsa bodies.

Nymphs #14-22 Dark brown bead heads, PT's, Flashbacks, Copper Johns, Midge Pupas, Prince, etc

Streamers #8-4 Dark and Bright colors. Cone head buggers, ESL's, Clousers, Articulated Leech, Double Bunnies, etc.

Attractors #18-10 Bring your favorites and present them well! Also Royal Wullf's #18-12 Traditional and Assorted Colors, Stimulators #12-8 Orange / Brown, Tarantulas #12-8 Red, Orange or Yellow, PMX's #12-8 Rusty Orange, Parachute Adams, Elk Hairs.

Fall - Mid Sept-Nov:

Midges / Choronomids #24 Neon Green with white wing adult. Also Cream and Black. Grey / Black emerger and pupa.

Giant Orange Sedge #10-6 BIG bug, burnt orange body dark grey/brown wing. Orange Stimulator.

Hoppers #10-6 Sage / Brown with pale yellow body. Dave's, parachute, foam bodied, Swishers PMX or similar.

Streamers #8-4 Dark colors. Cone head buggers, ESL's, Clousers, Articulated Leech, etc.

BWO Baetis #16-22 Dark grey wing with dark olive body. Olive "No Hackles", traditionals, soft hackles, emergers and Parachute Adams.

Caddis #14-20 Brown and Black. Elk hairs, Goddard's, etc. Emerging and pupa patters also.

PMD's #14-18 Wings get darker grey later season, body is pale yellow/grey. Parachute, Thorax, Compara or Emerging PMD's with trailing shuck, soft hackles and Rusty Spinners.

Mahogany Duns #14-16 Burgundy brown bodies with dark grey wings. Emergers, Soft Hackles and Duns.

Nymphs #14-22 Dark brown bead heads, PT's, Flashbacks, Copper Johns, Midge Pupas, Prince, etc

Streamers #8-4 Dark and Bright colors. Cone head buggers, ESL's, Clousers, Articulated Leech, Double Bunnies, etc.

Attractors #18-10 Bring your favorites and present them well! Also Royal Wullf's #18-12 Traditional and Assorted Colors, Stimulators #12-8 Orange / Brown, Tarantulas #12-8 Red, Orange or Yellow, PMX's #12-8 Rusty Orange, Parachute Adams, Elk Hairs.
